Meeting Minutes

February 10, 2020

- The meeting began at 3:08 p.m. with a welcome from Mrs. Foley and a review of the minutes from the previous meeting. The minutes were approved by all.
- Mrs. Foley shared that Real Men Read Day will be the last Friday of March. The month of March is focused on reading which kicks off with Living Literature Day. Real Men Read Day is a great way to get male role models into classrooms to read to students and talk about how reading is important for their careers.
- Mrs. Foley distributed Winter MAP data to everyone in the group to review. She explained how the report was broken down into grade levels and categories of low, low average, average, high average, and high. After giving everyone a moment to look over the data, Mrs. Foley summarized the score comparisons from fall to winter and praised all grade levels for notable growth in math and reading. First grade was highlighted as showing great improvements in both math and reading.

- Mrs. Foley thanked CCTC for participating in our STEAM Night. Mrs. Spigner shared some highlights of the night and expressed her gratitude for all of the hard work that went into making it such a success.
- Mrs. Foley introduced Mrs. Dennisse Jones, our Shaw Air Force Base liaison officer. She explained that Mrs. Jones works with our school as a support person for students from military families. Mrs. Jones took a moment to explain the services she is able to provide to military families and asked us to let her know of new incoming students that are a part of military families so she can reach out to them.
